There is no provision of funds/budget under the Scheme. States/UTs have flexibility to fix their own targets.

Vocational Skills Development: This will be implemented through online/blended mode in **convergence** with different Ministries/ Departments at Central and State/UT level. There is no provision of funds/budget under the Scheme. States/UTs have flexibility to fix their own targets.

Continuing Education: It includes engaging holistic adult education courses in arts, science, technology, culture, sports, recreation, as well as other topics of interest or use to local learners, such as more advanced material on critical life skills. This will be implemented in **convergence** with Department of Higher Education and other relevant Ministries/Departments at central and state/UT level. There is no provision of funds/budget under the Scheme. States/UTs have flexibility to fix their own targets.
